How Do We Use Your Donations?

£11 will pay for a feeding tube for a child that is no longer able to eat solids

£20 could pay for memory boxes to help children and their families capture special memories

£100 could help pay for a crisis visit for a Hospice at Home nurse during a medical emergency

£2,500 funds the cost of portable oxygen cylinders for a year for the children that need it, including emergency situations.

£5,500 could pay for a post bereavement weekend for siblings that have lost a brother or sister.

£11,000 could fund a specialist ‘safe’ bed for children who would otherwise need to be restrained during rest and sleep time, due to seizures and thrashing.

£52,000 is the cost to employ one of our clinical nurse specialist

Developments at Shooting Star Chase

- ◆ Supporting more babies, children & young people with life limiting conditions, and their families (currently support 700 families)
- ◆ Awarded an Outstanding rating for Shooting Star House hospice (Hampton) in the 2015 Care Quality Commission Inspection
- ◆ Recruited two social workers to ensure families access the right levels of support from all Government agencies and providing trained support to our families.
- ◆ Recruited a Transition Coordinator to support young adults and families through what can be a difficult transition into adult support.
- ◆ Further investment in our Hospice at Home service.
- ◆ Increase of short break nights at our hospices
- ◆ Starting a refurbishment plan in 2016 for Christopher’s hospice in Guildford
